

Schools in the project



<u>Democratic schools</u> based on deep democracy and ecology, where each student is free to decide on his/her engagement. Schools put great emphasis on community building, respect for cultural diversity, communicating one's needs in open and emphatic way, connection with nature.



<u>Innovative special needs schools</u> for pupils with light, modern and strong mental retardation. Methods applied: biofeedback, recording studio, music therapy, art therapy, handicraft, hippotherapy, dogotherapy, polysensory park.

Montessori and Waldorf schools with alternative approach, nature-based methods, ecology, Non-Violence Communication, handicraft.



<u>Upper Secondary Schools</u> active in European non-formal education, active citizenship, volunteering and international cooperations.

<u>Forest kindergarden</u> Children spend a lot of time outside, climbing trees. They enjoy the benefits of nature and learn to live in harmony with it. In line with the idea that the best way for children to develop harmoniously is to accompany them, follow them, give them the opportunity to be themselves in nature and respond to their individual needs.

Participant tasks

- organization of the non-formal activities strengthening pupils' psychosocial skills, wellbeing and school community
- participation in school's activities and daily life of the school community
- co-organization of contests, reviews, fairs, exhibitions, festivals, workshops, events
- co-organization of school trips, outdoor expeditions
- organization of intercultural activities based on youth worker own home culture and traditions
- language classes by non-formal methods

- Polish language classess
- promoting the idea of solidarity, European Union and voluntary service
- implementation of participant own educational projects, depending on hobbies, interests and passions, by the use of non-formal methods
- building positive relations with local community, engaging citizens in youth worker projects
- sharing success stories and project results on FB, Instagram, blog, website












Practical Arrangements

- work max 38 hours per week, including language classes, job preparation, trainings
- comfy flats shared with other youth workers
- pocket money /120 Euro per month/
- local transportation card
- food allowance /130 euro per month/
- travel reimbursement up to 275/360 Euro
- medical insurance

Virtual

opportunites

- Due to Covid-19 there it is possible to start cooperation virtually, working from your own country.
- We have prepared program of online cooperation: training, coaching meetings with tutor and other ESC youth workers, specific tasks
- Working virtually, you have a right to receive pocket money.
- Once it is possible you can come over to Poland physically and start cooperation at the school normally.
