# **EUROPEAN COMMISSION ANNOUNCES** A NEW OFFICIAL LANGUAGE: LANGUAGE!

# BREAKING NEWS

Starting from 25th October 2024, all the programme guidelines will be written in a language that all EU residents will understand, even your grandmother!

First EVS volunteer gets reimbursed by the insurance after 26 years, unfortunately in a currency that no longer exists!

There is hope for all the participants of the EVS, now ESC, programme. Mario Rossi, first volunteer to benefit from the crossborder volunteering programme, just received the money back from the health service he used in 1998.

The European Commission decided that it's finally time to approve a new role in the ESC programme.

All NGOs who would like to host volunteers with fewer opportunities must make sure they have in their organization someone who understands the disability and sees the ability in it. No more youth workers who pretend to know something about inclusion!

Youth work finally recognised across the EU!

Desperation is rising European mothers now that youth work has been officially recognised. They will need now to find new questions to ask their kids besides "When are you going to find a serious job?"

No more confusion in ESC projects! From now on, all National Agencies across the EU will follow the same rules, a real tragedy for all the fans of their creative work so far. Check-ins will be carried out on a regular basis to make sure of it. Honesty, just make them work.

### **ESC GUIDELINES 2025**

The European Commission approves new rules for the ESC Programme allocating additional budget to language courses for volunteers in the pre-departure phase or doing the volunteering in order to escape the Tower of Babel and reduce the accesses to Duolingo. The potential volunteers will go through a mandatory selection process that all NGOs involved in the Programme will carry out in a clear and transparent way. Only breathing and being willing to go abroad won't be enough to get selected.

We also announce the introduction of NA's crossborder monitoring. In order to ensure a better functioning and implementation of the Programme, officers from a foreign NA's will check that projects in other countries are being implemented correctly and their NA is supporting them. Moreover, ESC guidelines 2024 will be canceled and the accession to long-term and short-term will go back to ESC guidelines 2023.

# **VOLU\_M\_EXPERIENCE**

VOLU.M.Experience / 19 - 25.10.2024 / Lefkosia (Cyprus) was a training having as a target group EX (EVS/ESC) volunteers who are still involved or potentially involved in the field of youth work – we aimed to gather the experience and perspectives of former volunteers as participants in volunteering projects and define issues, content, topics related to volunteer management, so that future projects may rely on lessons learned from practice, for improved quality implementation

The six day training involved and evolved around activities in an effort of distilling the precious experience of the participants as end beneficiaries of the European Solidarity Program. Exploring their personal learning experience and growth, sharing stories with persons that could understand the common experience and eventually developing a common story of the experience with the storytelling tool "Kamishibai". Eventually the participants, once going deeper within their experience, and understanding the structure of the ECS program and its actors, worked on creative presentations for a publication "ESC at its Best!!"



Outcomes will be published in some due time. Stay Tuned!!

The training funded by the Erasmus Plus program was based on non-formal methods and focused on the personal learning experience of the participants.



# THE GOOD RECIPE TO CREATE **MUFFINS**

### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1 kg of training course (for a strong foundation) • 250 grams of international experience (for global flavor)
- . 300 ml of communication skills (the secret ingredient) • Extra international experience (to taste)
- 1 or 2 big spoons of patience (essential for rising)
- A sprinkle of extra ECS experience (to add zest)

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

I. \*\*PREHEAT YOUR MIND\*\*:

Set your mindset to "open" and "curious." This will create the perfect environment for your Mentor Muffins to rise!

2.\*\*MIX THE FOUNDATION\*\*

In a large mixing bowl, combine the 1 kg of training course with the 300 ml of communication skills.

Whisk together until smooth—this is the base that will hold your muffins together.

3. \*\*STIR IN THE FLAVOR\*\* Gradually fold in 250 grams of international experience, adding extra international experience to taste. This will infuse your muffins with diverse perspectives.

4. \*\*ADD PATIENCE\*\*: Carefully mix in 1 or 2 big spoons of patience. Remember, good things take time to develop, just like a great mentor!

5. \*\*ZEST IT UP\*\*: Sprinkle in plenty of extra ECS experience. This will give your muffins a unique twist and a dash of excitement.

6. \*\*BAKE WITH CARE\*\*: Pour the mixture into muffin tins, filling each cup to about ¾ full. Bake in a preheated oven at 180°C (350°F) for 20-25 minutes, or until they're golden brown and spring back when touched.

### 7. \*\*COOL AND SHARE\*\*

Let your Mentor Muffins cool slightly before serving. Share them with volunteers seeking guidance, encouraging them to enjoy the wisdom baked into each bite.

### **SERVING SUGGESTION:**

Pair with a warm cup of inspiration and serve at ESC projects. These muffins are best enjoyed in a collaborative atmosphere where everyone can add their own experiences!


